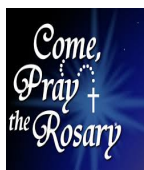
Isaiah 42:1-4,6-7

Gospel Summary



Most of Mark's accounts of the events in Jesus' life are short and to the point. The account of Jesus' Baptism given in today's Gospel illustrates this. In a few brief sentences Mark tells of the Baptism of Jesus in the Jordan River by John the Baptist. The brevity of the final verse of the passage makes it unclear whether Jesus

alone heard the voice that came from the heavens, or if everyone who witnessed his Baptism heard the same. What is clear from the words is the special relationship Jesus had with God the Father. -RCLB
