No need to sort just bring them to the Church Lobby in plastic bags and follow the arrow. Tax receipt available upon request.

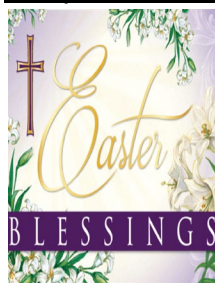
