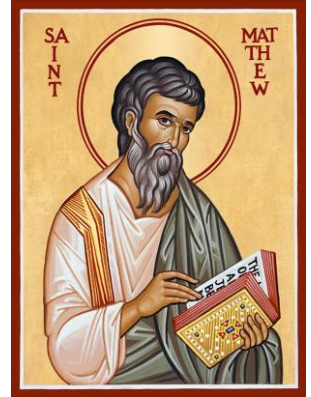

**Ezekiel 17:22-24, 2 Corinthians 5:6-10; Mark 4:26-34**

### Gospel Summary



The fourth chapter of Mark's Gospel focuses entirely on parables. In the first part of the Gospel, Seed Grows of Itself, Jesus is pointing out that the growth of the Kingdom of God is a hidden reality that operates under God's power rather than through human work and effort. In the second part of the Gospel, the parable of the Mustard Seed, Jesus is offering the crowds words of encouragement. What at first might seem small and insignificant will, under God's power, become "the largest of plants."- RCLB
