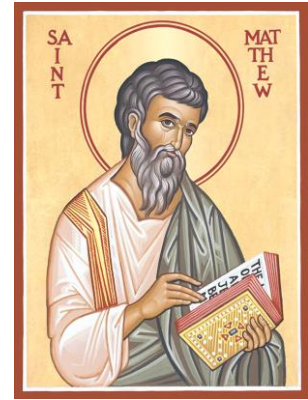

## **RaiseRight Fundraising**

A new, easy fundraising opportunity! With RaiseRight fundraising, we can raise money by using gift cards instead of cash or credit to pay for everyday purchases like groceries, gas, dining out, that morning coffee addiction, even your family's summer vacation. There are 750+ participating retailers (including Starbucks and Amazon). Sign up by either downloading the **RaiseRight** app to your phone or going to **RaiseRight.com** on your computer. You will need to securely link your checking account to pay for the gift cards. There are three types of cards:

- **Physical gift cards** - traditional plastic retailer gift cards.
- **eGift cards** - Electronic gift cards (eGift cards) can be used for online and in-store purchases. eGift cards are delivered within a minute to your RaiseRight wallet for immediate use.
- **Reloadable gift cards** – Some shops (like Albertsons, Arco, Shell) require you to have a physical gift card, rather than an eGift card, to make purchases. Purchase the physical gift card and reload it from the RaiseRight app up to 99 times.

Initial orders for physical/refillable cards are due **9:00 pm on 11/19/22** so that we can have gift cards available for personal use and Christmas gifts (for teachers, mail carriers, friends and family, etc.). Make sure to select Ship to Coordinator, not Ship to Home. They will be available for pick up at church the following Sundays 11/27/22 and 12/3/22. This fundraiser isn't limited to Saint Matthew parishioners – invite friends and family and anyone who wants to support our church.
