### ALL: AND ALSO WITH YOU THE SPRINKLING OF HOLY WATER

Presider: Lord God almighty,

We ask you to bless us with Holy Water

Lord, in your mercy,

Give us living water, always springing up as a fountain Of salvation: Free us, body, and soul, from every danger, And admit us to your presence.

(The Presider sprinkles water during the Gloria)

#### **Profession of Faith**

Do you believe in Jesus Christ, his only Son, our Lord, who was born of Mary, was crucified and died, and was buried? – ALL: YET HE ROSE FROM THE DEAD AND IS SEATED AT THE RIGHT HAND OF THE FATHER. AMEN! AMEN! AMEN! AMEN,WE DO BELIEVE.
